# BUILDING & GROUNDS REMINDERS

All deliveries of large-scale household products (i.e. furniture) must not be made in July or August unless in emergency circumstances. Due to the nature of our difficult to navigate streets we just can't accommodate having large trucks going through the Campgrounds at this time. We've had electrical wires taken down, cottages clipped, and loud beeping alarms going off when the trucks back up.

If you have an emergency situation, please alert the office as soon as possible so B&G can be on-site to help navigate the best way to get to your cottage.

We've also had a few instances of contractors on the Campground during July and August - which we do not allow. Contractors are only permitted to work on the Campground outside of July and August and must go through our COA process.

If there is an emergency repair, you must inform our B&G Supervisor, Frannie Capello prior to work being done.

The office has received an influx of calls and complaints about unleashed dogs, dogs in Trinity Park, and excessive barking.

Below is a reminder of our dog policy, which is included in the MVCMA General Rules & Regulations which can be found on our website.

6. Dogs must be on leash at all times when not on their owner's leased lot. Residents and their guests to the Campground must clean up after their pets immediately. Dogs cannot be left tied to porches or left in yards unsupervised. No dog should be tied on common ground. Residents must make every effort to assure their dogs do not annoy neighbors with excessive barking.

Any vehicle parked in a MVCMA parking area or leasehold must have a current MVCMA parking sticker or hang tag. Any vehicles parked on MVCMA roads (where permitted) must have a current MVCMA parking sticker or hang tag except during Tabernacle events. No vehicles may be parked on Trinity Circle overnight, from July 1st - August 31st.
